Sunday, November 25, 2012 Spiritual Steps to Spiritual Decisions

Psalm 23:3

Life is a series of choices and decisions. Success is basically a matter of making wise decisions. If we constantly make dumb decisions then we will fail in life.

We make our decisions and our decisions make us. Every decision has a consequence, and, without doubt, we all become products of the decisions we make.

Four Steps to Decision Making:

1. Surrender Your Way to God's Way

Isaiah 53:6 (NLT) All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the Lord laid on him the sins of us all.

2. Ask in Faith for Direction

Matthew 7:7-8 (NKJV) ⁷ "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

3. Position Yourself for God's Answer

Job 33:14 (NLT) For God speaks again and again, though people do not recognize it.

4. Respond in Faith When You Don't Understand

Proverbs 4:18 (NLT) The way of the righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, which shines ever brighter until the full light of day.

Proverbs 3:5-7 (NKJV) ⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. ⁷ Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the Lord and depart from evil.
